#### **ISSUE 8**

In Ephesians chapter one, Paul writes a long Greek sentence that begins in verse three and doesn't end until verse fourteen. In this unusually longwinded decree, we see the Apostle repeatedly use the phases, "in Christ," "in the Beloved." or "in Him:" used nine times in just twelve verses. The word rendered "in" in our English translations. comes from the Greek preposition  $\delta v$ , pronounced "en." It is defined as, "a marker of position." It involves identity and location. Paul wants the Ephesians to fully understand their position, location, and identity in Christ is why God can bless them as He does.

So, we must ask ourselves, what does this lengthy sentence (Eph. 1:3-14) say concerning the believer's position, location, identity, and blessings in the Savior? Let's take a look:

- [God and Father] ... has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ. •
- blameless before Him.
- the Son].
- to the riches of His grace which He lavished on us.
- times, that is, the summing up of all things in Christ, things in the heavens and things on the earth.
- of His glory.
- the redemption of God's own possession, to the praise of His glory.

Let me encourage you to take a few moments this month to review this powerful letter to the Ephesians with an eve for this phrase "in Him."
